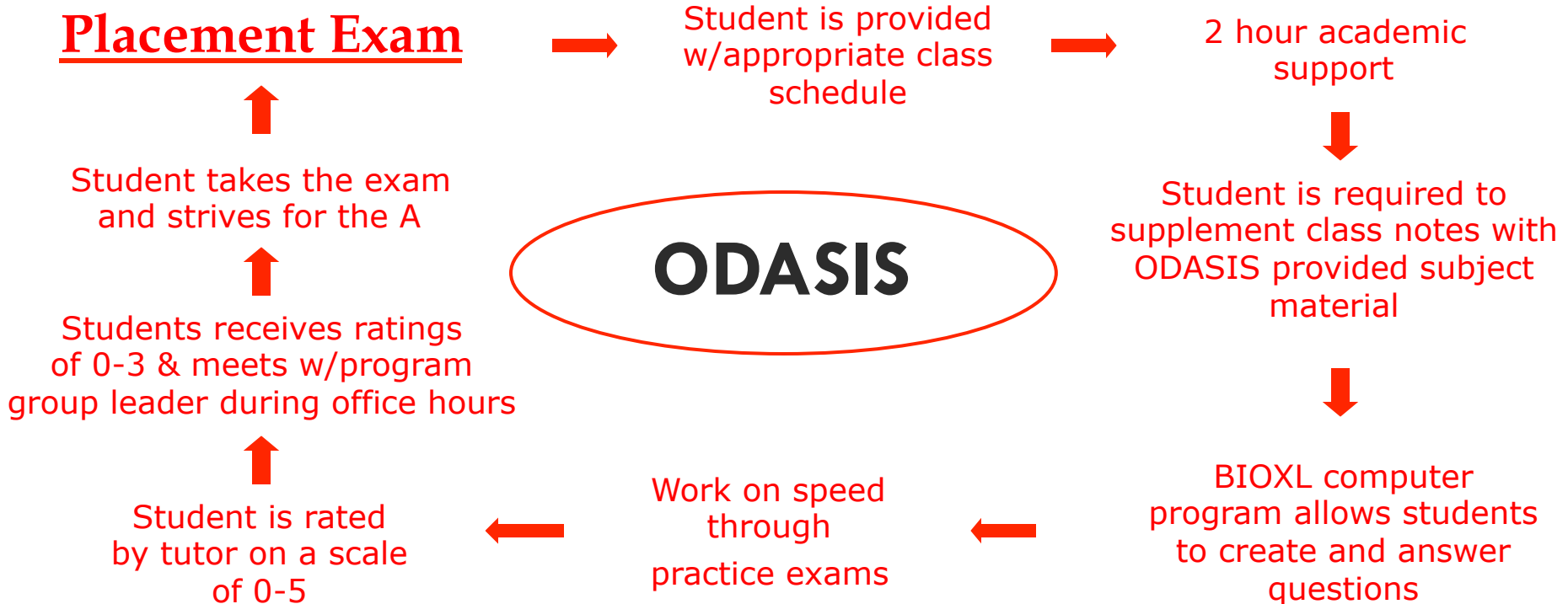

Out of **72** schools, last year the AAMC ranked Rutgers University, New Brunswick as...

- ❑ **4th** for sending **African American** students to medical school
- ❑ **39th** for sending **Hispanic/Latino** students to medical school

2014 ODASIS RESULTS

Through the implementation of academic advising, supplemental support, MCAT/DAT prep courses, and medical school prep programs like Access-Med, last year's ODASIS results include:

- ❑ An average MCAT composite score of 27.58
 - ❑ National average is 25.3
- ❑ 67 students were accepted to medical schools including:
